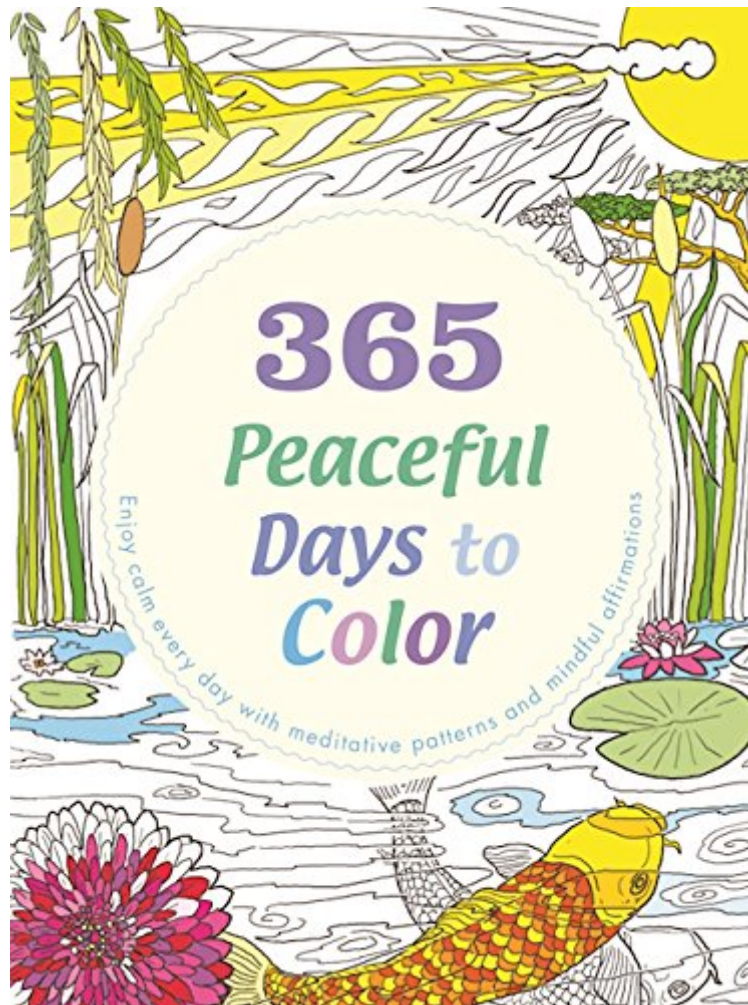

A little more than 3/4 of each page is a doodle or picture to color, and the bottom section has the date and an affirmation or meditation quote of some kind. The picture does not go into the binding, the bottom bar and the binding are a solid color (each month has its own color). There is a wide variety of pictures in the book, so it should have something for everyone. The cons: Pictures are on both sides of the pages, so be careful with what medium you use, as you can ruin the other side of the page. The paper is ok, I don't think it's super thin but its also not thick paper. The biggest disappointment for me, (that i couldn't tell when purchasing) is that a tiny bit of each picture is already colored (example photo attached). I know there are coloring books like that out

there and some people don't mind, but it's not my cup of tea.
