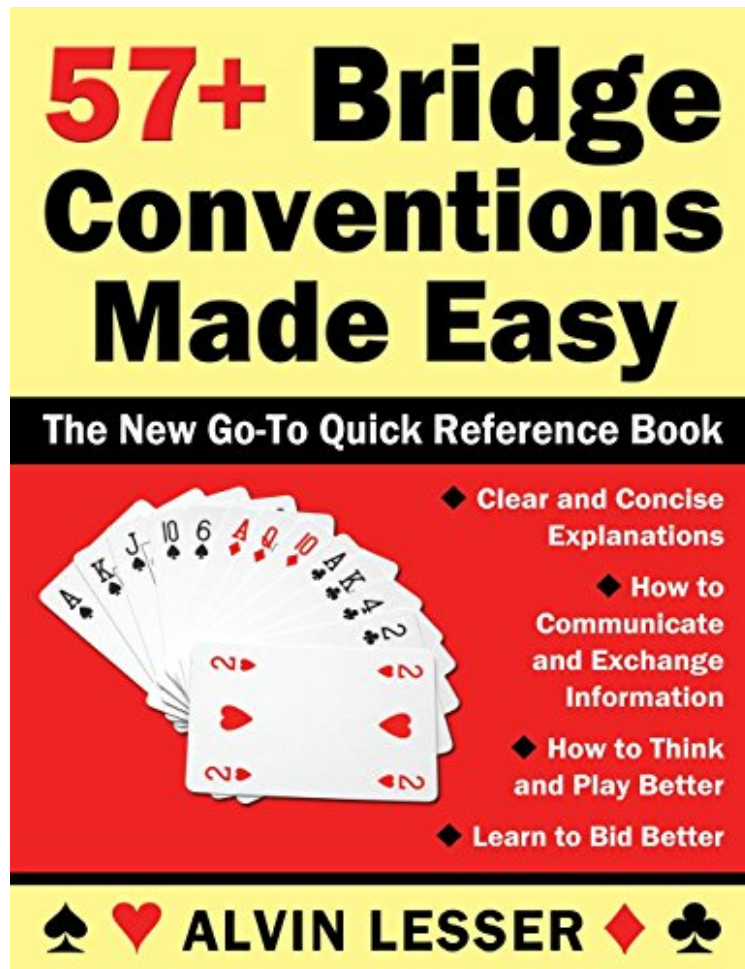

By Iorweth To start with the positive: the information is delivered in a unique way that is easy to comprehend and remember. Top marks! Alas, the text is riddled with errors that should have been caught by even casual proof reading, and there are some logical inconsistencies in the suggested bidding sequences. These are serious errors that may trap and mislead the improving

player, so I am only awarding 3 stars. A careful purging of these blunders would make this an easy 5 star recommendation.
