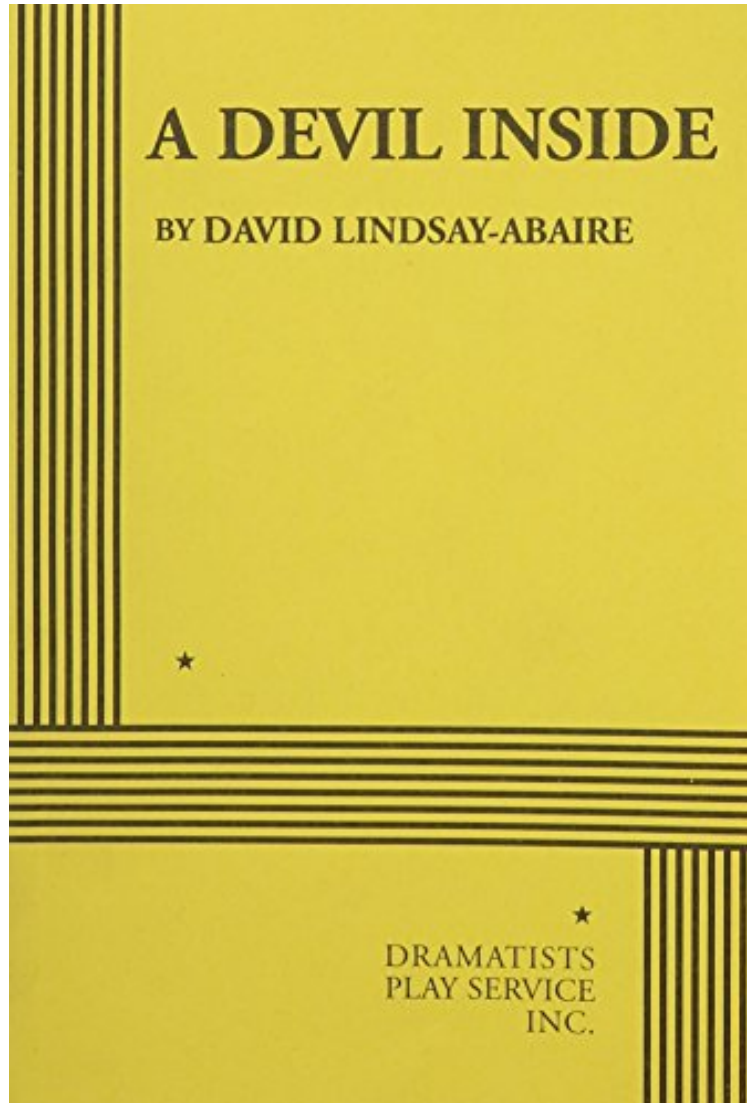

There isn't any witty dialogue or clever observations. There are no musing about modern life or relationships. Every character in the play has experienced a tragedy, with most of them experiencing multiple tragedies. Like the Russian

literature that the playwright is both inspired by and clearly satirizing, these tragedies are connected and the play unwinds those connections as it moves from scene to scene. This was Mr. Lindsay-Abaire's second play - his skill obviously increased in time between this and "Rabbit Hole."
