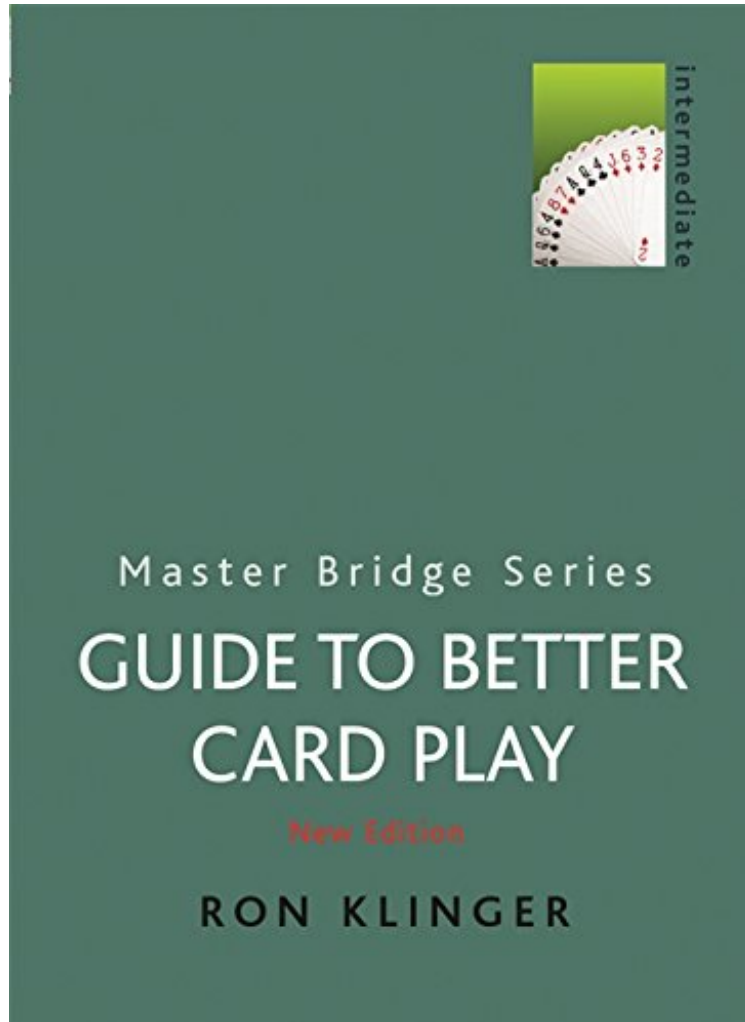

Typically Klinger, the typesetting is tight and the answers (at the back) are tiny and require magnification to read. But oh the quality! For the past dozen years, I have been searching for a book that could communicate declarer play as well as this book, and I can say that this is the only one I have found that accomplishes that goal. Other books may be good at what they do, but this book does it all -- and makes it easy to digest. But don't read it from cover to cover. Pick a topic,

read about it, take the quiz, read it again. You will understand why this was the Book of the Year from the American Bridge Teachers Association. It deserved the recognition.
