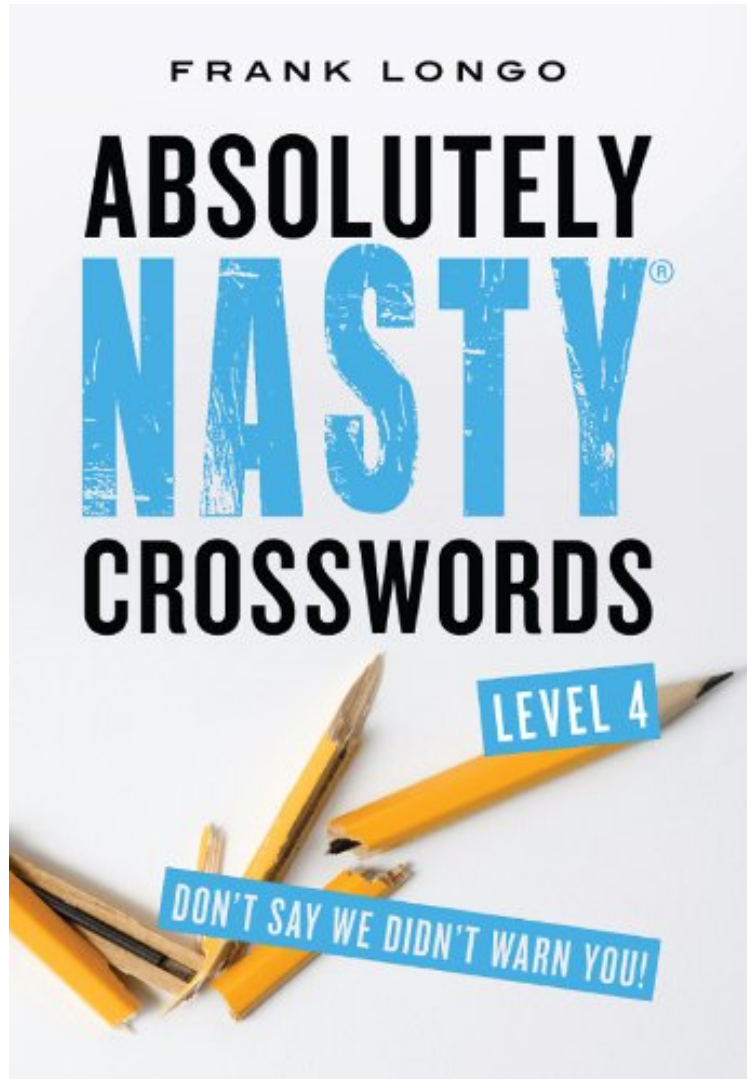

is a bit of a reach, but there is no question that this is an excellent book of difficult crossword puzzles. Through the 72 puzzles in this book, I was able to do only about one-third without look-ups. Longo's clever definitions may mystify at first, but they make your mind work hard, and when you find the answer, you can see how well it satisfies the definition.
