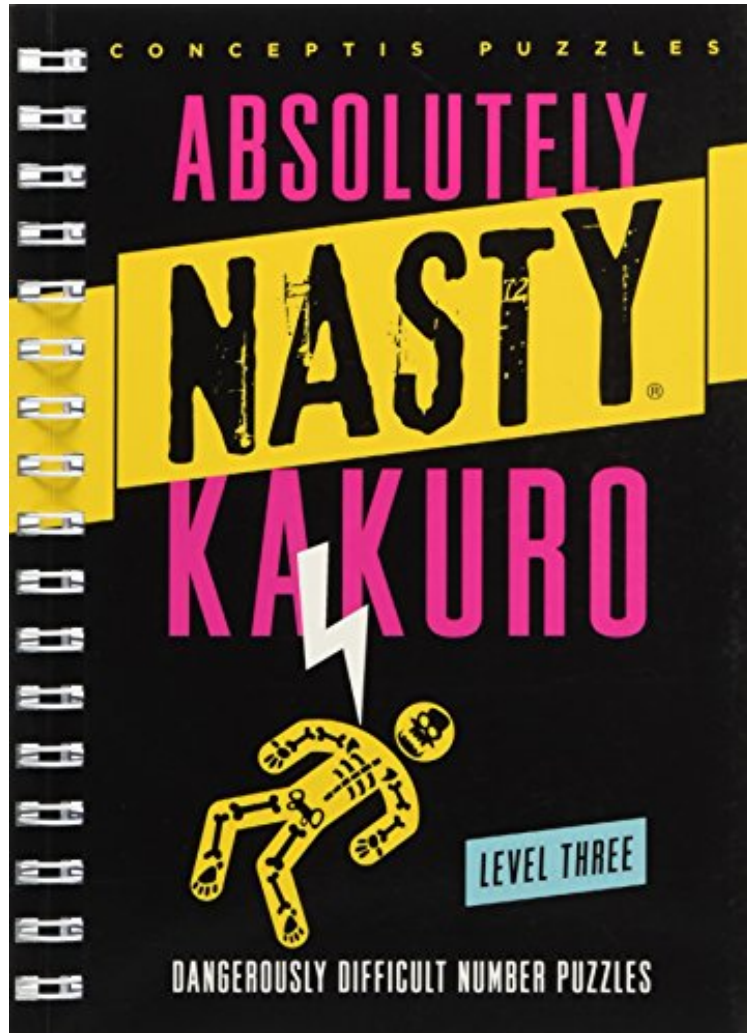

The paper is durable and erases cleanly with a polymer eraser (no pencil erasers please). The spiral binding is first class.
