really insightful on how to play in a "big boys" game. Many people play poker, particularly Omaha, like video poker. Wait to hit a hand, and then get paid off big. In low stakes that might work as it is hard for anyone to push out draws. In "big boy" poker, good players use chips and position as much as cards to win pot after pot. If you have a video poker mindset, you will constantly be forced to risk your entire stack chasing draws, or calling down when you have 2nd nuts, and someone is representing the nuts. A much tougher game to play. This book will help you understand what the aggressive players are doing as well as to arm you with aggressive plays you can add to your arsenal.
