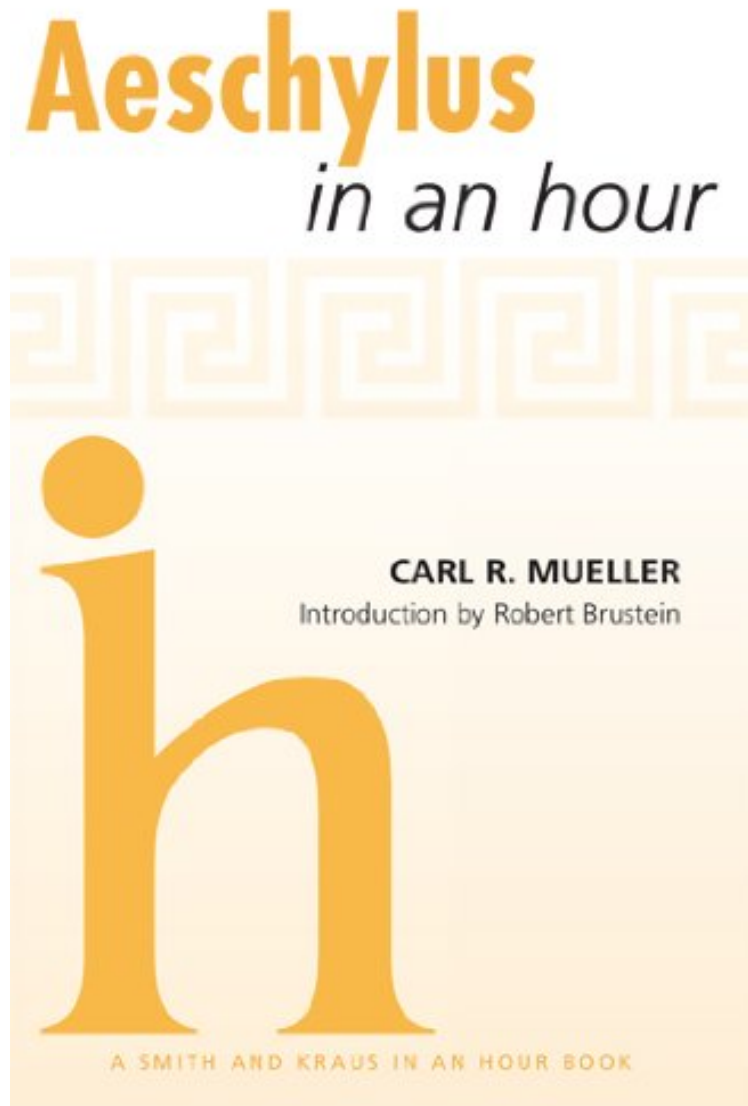


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## Aeschylus in an Hour (Playwrights in an Hour)

A translator for more than forty years, he translated and published works by Bchner, Brecht, Wedekind, Hauptmann, Hofmannsthal, and Hebbel, to name a few. For Smith and Kraus he translated individual volumes of plays by Schnitzler, Strindberg, Pirandello, Kleist, Goethe, and Wedekind and all four major Greek playwrights.
