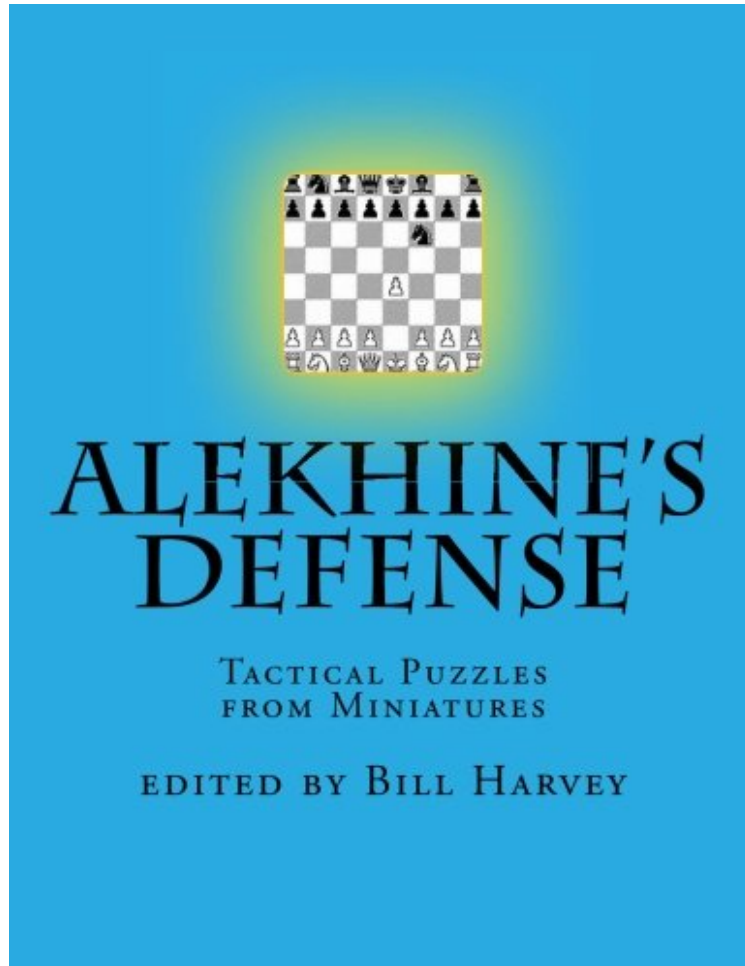

The book is similar with these short games. My only issue is that some of the solutions are just the winning move with no explanation why. While others puzzles they demonstrate while all other moves are bad. My other criticism is the book has a bias towards white, The majority of the book White wins. So its puzzles where black made a mistake. This means you may not be getting what you want out of this book, if your goal was to learn the defense from black's perspective. For the price and free shipping that I got this book for, its ok. Had this book cost more than six I would not recommend.

This is a collection of 417 puzzles taken from the first 20 moves of Alekhine's Defense chess opening play. Each

puzzle represents a stratagem nearly unique to the opening. A diagram marks the point of the critical position in the game. The remainder of the game along with variant solutions is found at the end of the book and is accompanied by a copy of the diagram. If you've ever wondered why Napoleon played this opening, this book will be for you.
