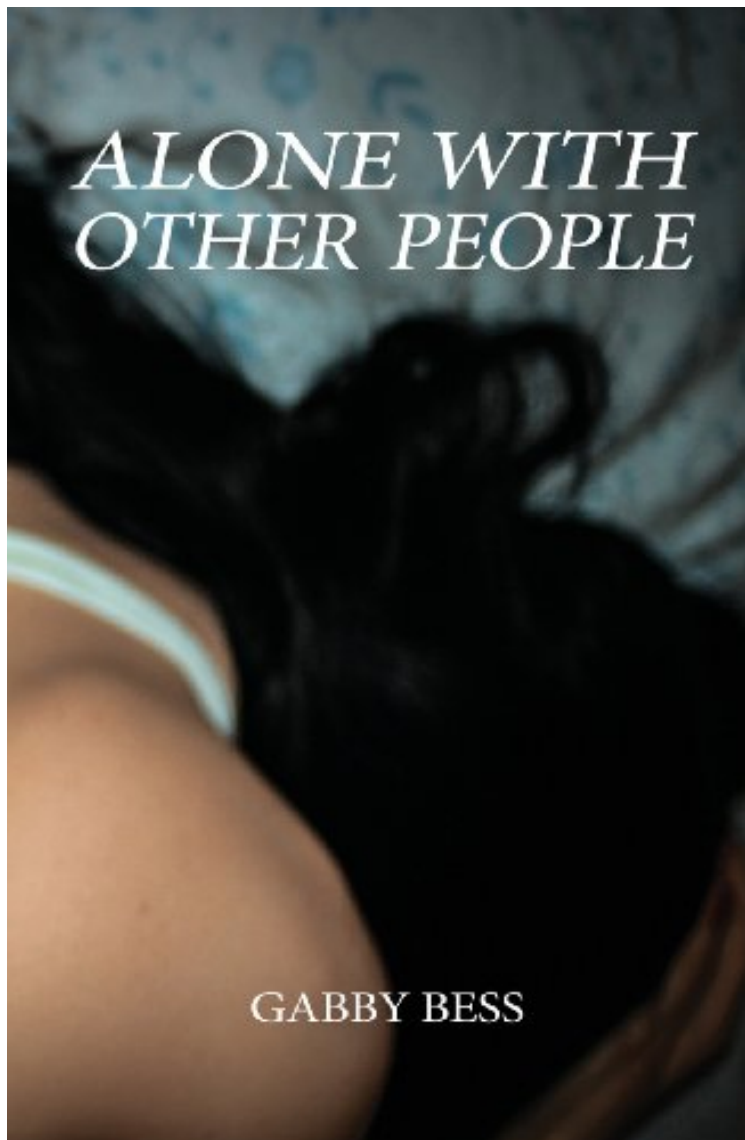

She picks up well on the idea of self representation, and how one's inner self can be accurately presented or gravely misrepresented in our over sharing social landscapes. She wonders if misplacing your dignity is the same as misplacing your lipstick, if feeling happy is better than feeling in love, and if selling out is a worthwhile goal for an artist.
