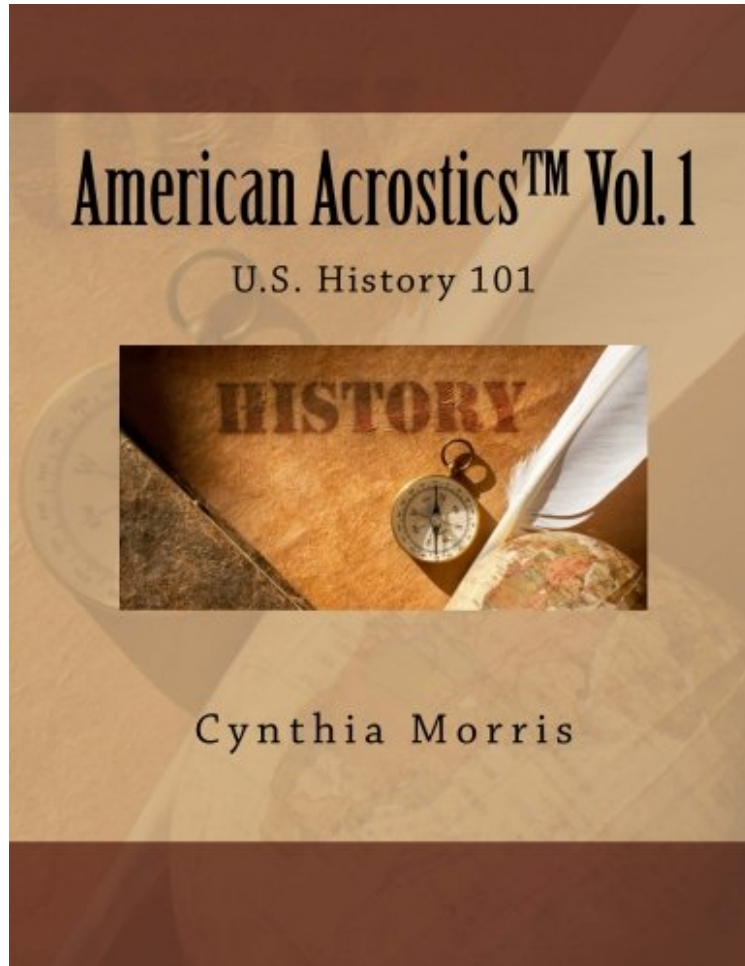

Cynthia Morris's puzzles are not quite as challenging or as well-constructed as his, but they are close enough.
