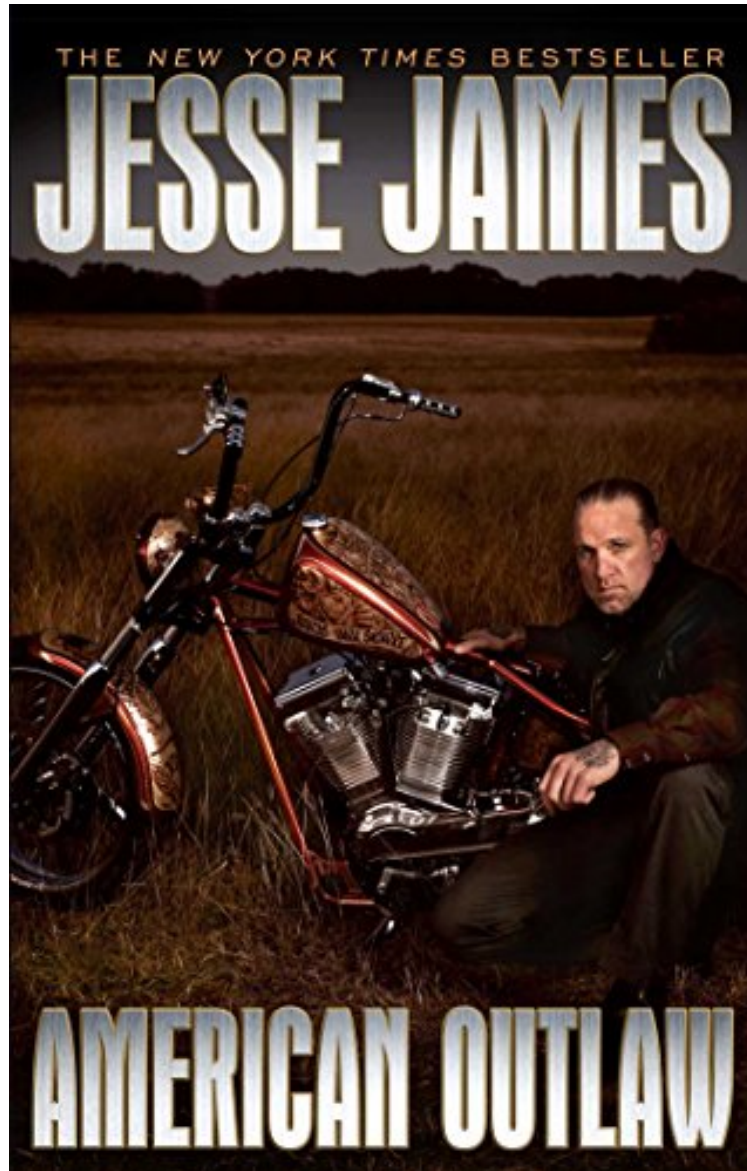

He reveals a lot of information I would not have expected, but clearly left some out. First of all, in the pictures he has a sister but never mentions her in the book. He also does not mention his mother more than a few times. He does chronicle his childhood (or lack of) well. He talks in depth about his relationship with his father. His life really is just one continuous interesting story.
