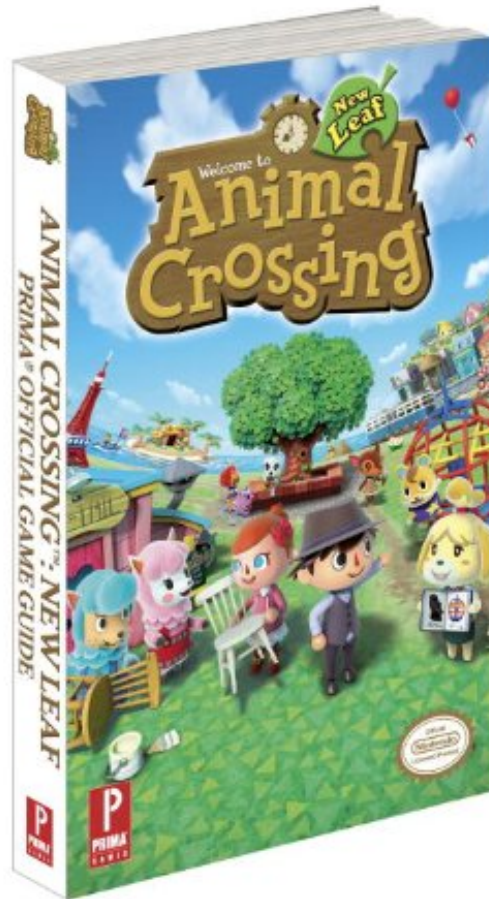

I know some of the biggest negatives in some reviews of this guide have been the pricing of items; that they price in the book is not actually the price you get when you sell items. But, it's not a big deal to me. I've played pretty much every version of Animal Crossing there is (across the Nintendo Consoles and handhelds), and the price you sell items for hasn't changed much from the last game. I have a general idea of which items will give me more bells (the game currency) anyway. And even if you're a new player, after a while you'll know which items to sell to make the most bells. This guide really sucks. It's printed in tiny fonts, and printed in poor quality. That's not the main problem. The problem is it lacks lots of information and contains tons of errors. For example, it does not tell you what the special characters like Tom Nook wants for coffee! It also makes looking up villagers' fav coffees really unintuitive, involving unnecessary cross-referencing between tables. You go to free FAQ sites like thonky and everything, I mean everything, is listed in a clear manner. The book also lacks information about the villagers, other than the most basic information. It doesn't have pictures for all the villagers... I bought it partly as a collectible but what good is an official guide without the portraits of our beloved villagers?? Many items' values are listed incorrectly. For instance, the music-room floor you get from Saharah is worth 1,800 bells, not 7,200 as given on p.95, the ringside seating wallpaper is worth 2,250 bells, not 9,000 as listed on p.96. The best times to catch bugs and fishes are listed in a weird way, and not all that helpful. For example, on p.495 you're told that the best time to catch a cyclommatus is, to quote, "August 1:0-2:15 (1%)". What does this mean? What's 1:0? Is that 1:00 am or 1:00 pm? Who uses 1:0 to format time??? Serioiusly!! HOw about this one: p.494 on jewel beetle "4:0-4:15". Just 15 minutes to catch this beetle? Am or pm? Poorly presented information like this fills the book. How to upgrade your TT shops is also inadequately described... Just too many problems with the book to list here. The category is not in alphabetic order, making it extremely difficult to navigate. I gave up after trying to mark the tops/shirts category. There are also some mistakes in the book. For example, the No. 1 shirt is listed as No. 0 shirt, No. 23 shirt is listed as No. 6 shirt... It's funny as the picture clearly demonstrates that this is a No. 23 shirt. These are just a few mistakes I noticed. I believe there are more in this book. So as a guidance book, it's difficult to navigate and the information is not accurate. I don't see a point of getting this book. 2 Stars are given merely because animal crossing is a great game.
