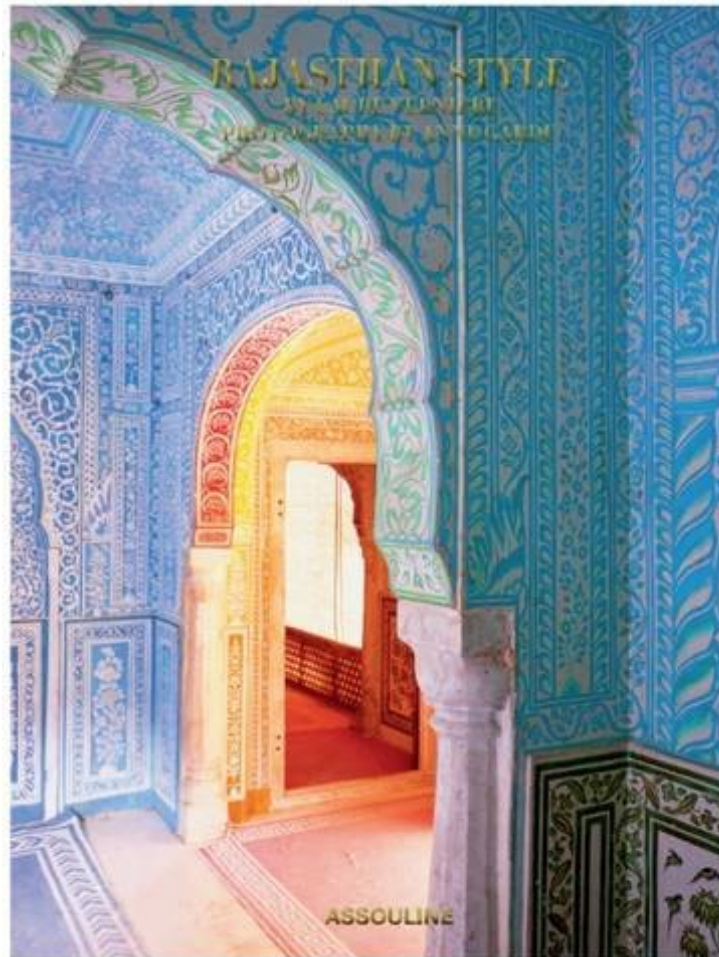


## Rajasthan Style (Classics)
