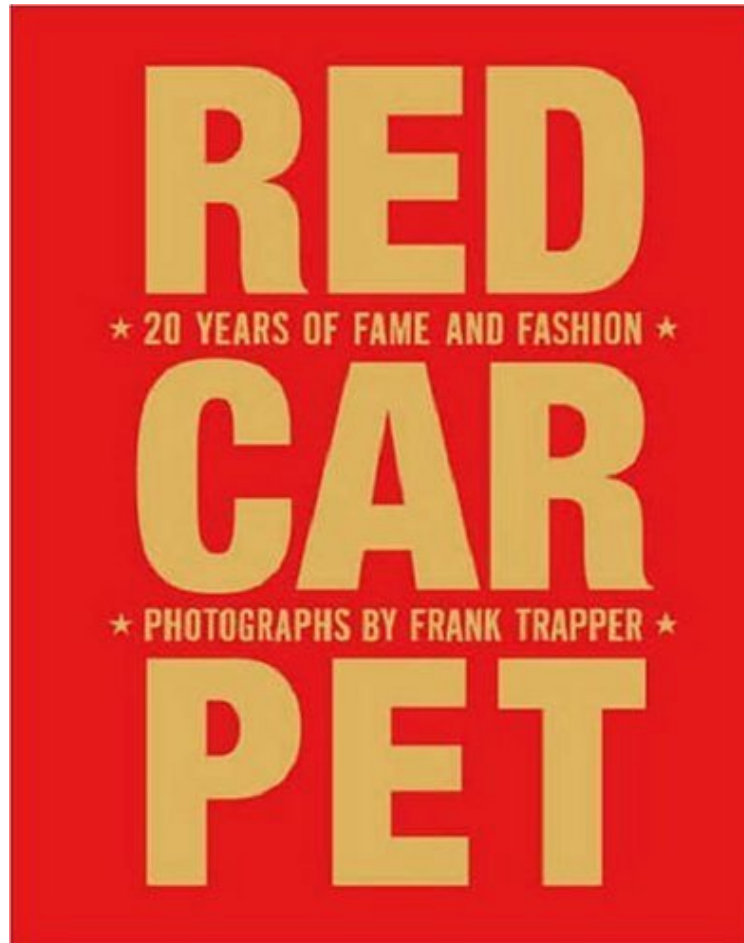

are right there. In the opening pages there is a photo of Angelina Jolie as a youngster with her family, probably the most interesting picture in the book for me as I had never seen her like that. An absolute load of photos, what you might see in 'People' magazine as the stars visit movie openings, awards shows and Arnold appears one time at a Planet Hollywood opening. Some theme spreads as siblings get their due and some are of actresses wearing the same color dresses to compare and contrast and a prego spread. Made me wonder if it is like an on-going prom as guys have to ask gals if they will go with them so the gal has to get a dress. We are witness to cleavage and tummies. One gal has a dress that looks like a bunch of credit cards. Some dresses are very tasteful while a few are silly. Set-up by years 1987 to 2007 some pages are of one person, some are two people and some are four people. At the end of the book are captions of who is photographed, the designer of their clothing, and where the photo was taken which is very helpful. A couple people are listed as 'guest' or 'date', so much for their 15 minutes of fame. Following the captions is an alphabetical index for celebrity and designer which is also very helpful.
