Paul McCartney's father basically turned the family camera over to his son, Michael, when he was becoming a teen and developing a passion for photography. The story this book tells is amazing; It's of the McCartney family, the Beatles meeting each other, playing in Hamburg, the Cavern Club, and follows Paul and "the lads", as well as others they were around through until the mid-60's. Michael also became a "Pop Star" for awhile during this time with his group, Scaffold, but he has been known through the years for his photographic exhibits and commissions.
