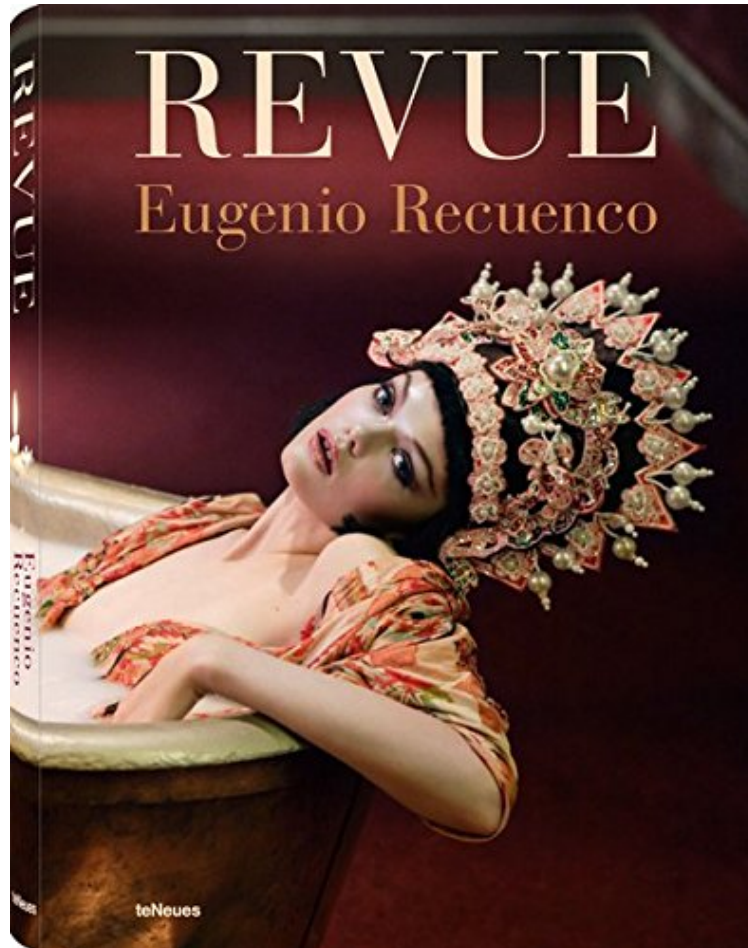

Beautiful photography, printing could be better By Russell Eugenio Recuenco's photography is stunning, and beautifully presented in this book. Very nice are the little details that say where shoots were done, what they were for, and personal notes. I wish the printing were better tho. I would say 1/3 to 1/2 of the pages have what looks like dust on them. But the dust must have been present in the printing process... leaving a lot of white specs particularly towards the outer edges of the pages, where the ink missed. (I will upload some photos from my book into the "customer photos") Some pages have a gritty feel to them, others are smooth... again making me think of dust in the print environment.
