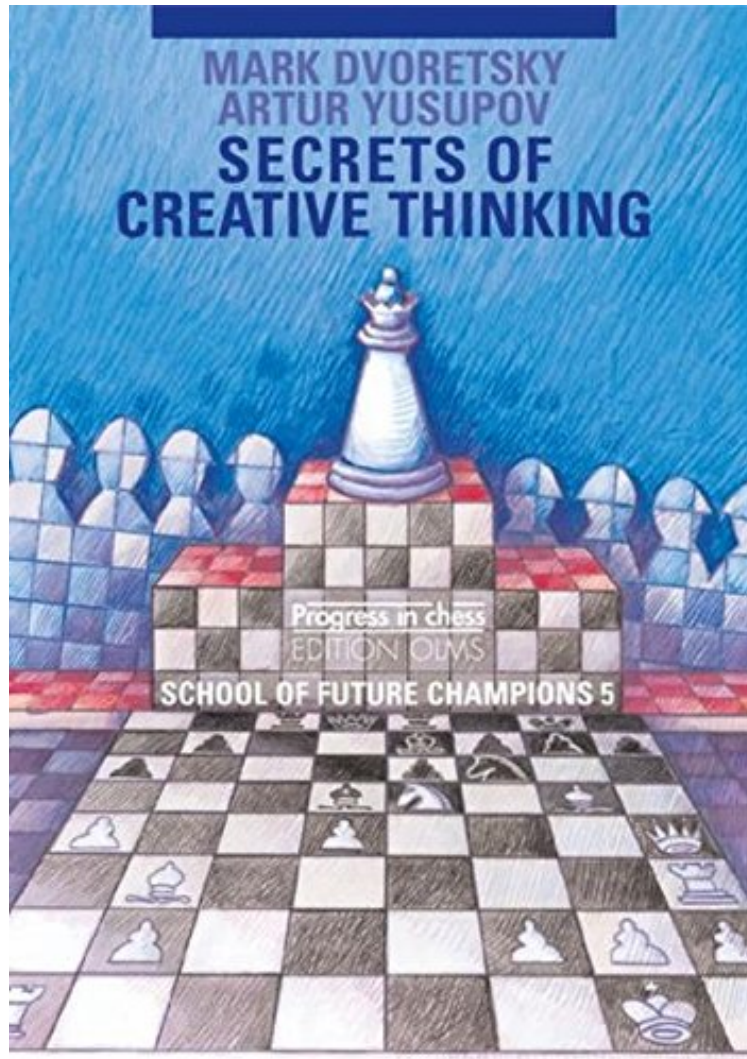

I have five of them, purchased during the last ten years, this being the most recently purchased one. Considering the subject, creative thinking, he does an excellent job of providing systematic methods for improvements in this area. It will take me a

while to get through this book - it is detailed even within the narrow realm of chess books. If you take your time (I use my iPad and a chess program to follow the various analysis paths and options) you will improve your understanding of how to maximize your own creative capabilities. The production quality of this book, like his other books, could not be better. The paper it is printed on is outstanding - opaque, very white, substantial and not at all glossy, and the typeface is as good as it could be. As I have gotten older I pay more attention to the brightness of the paper and the contrast between the paper and type, and the ability to read a book with just a single light at night is very valuable to me.
