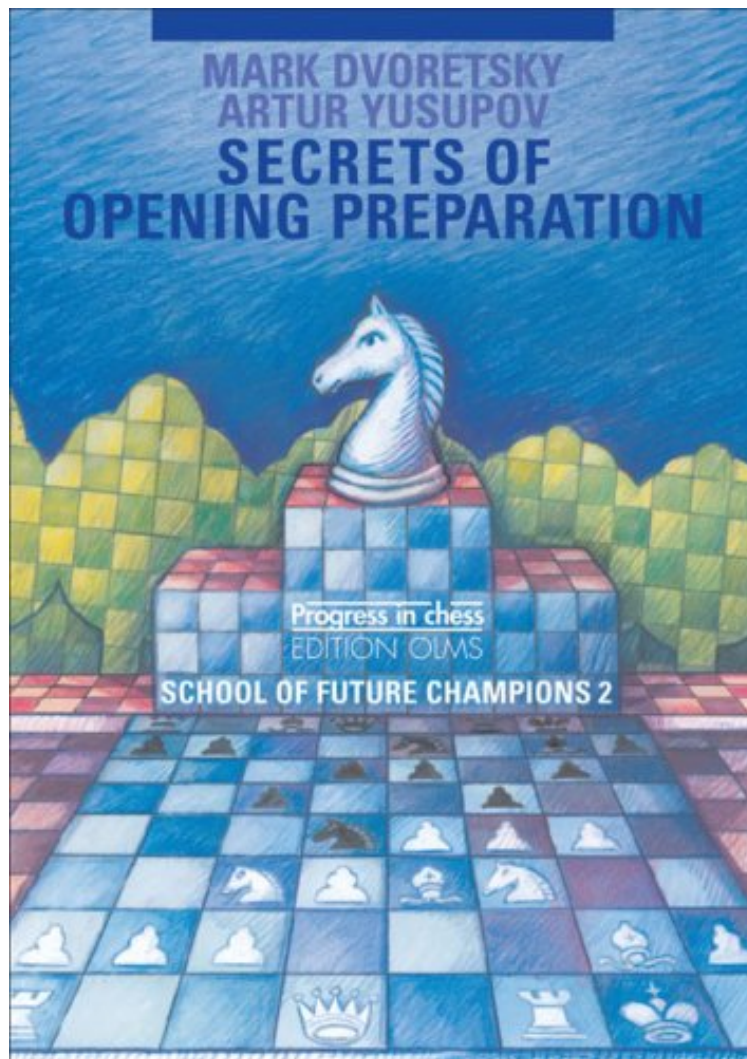

information into a notebook" and "in a notebook you can't insert new pages." He recommends "opening information should be recorded in a card index."
