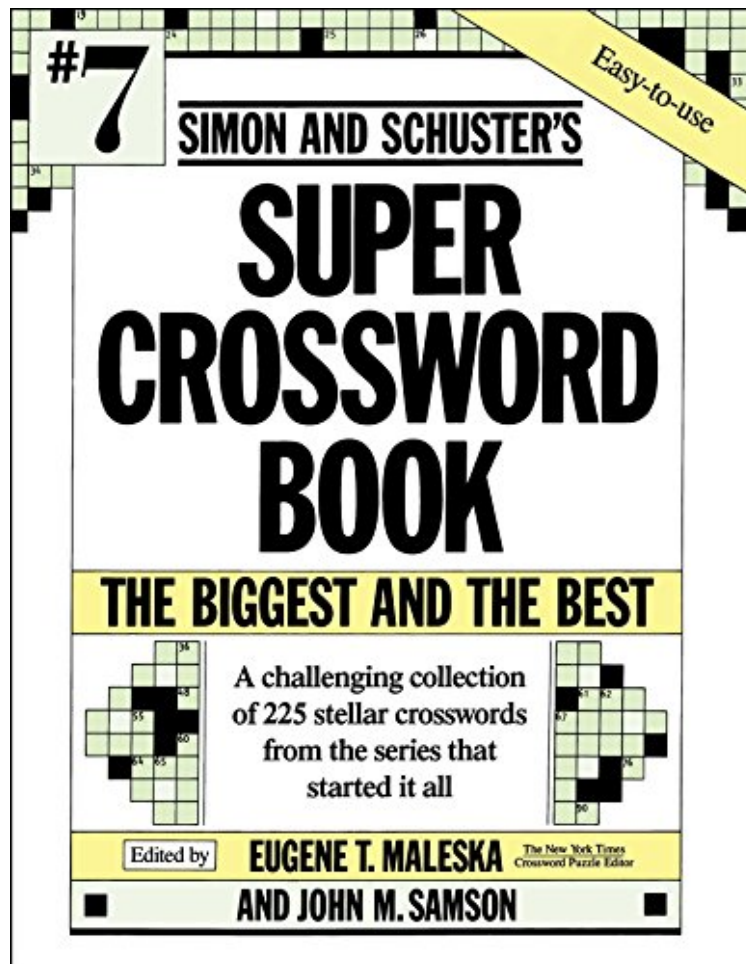

This latest edition is printed on slightly ecru paper that is courser and more absorbent. With roller ball pen the letters don't come out crisp. Pencil doesn't create a bright contrast. Ball point pen gets fuzz at the tip. The puzzles are still great, but the change in paper is disappointing. By CodeZebra I enjoy difficult crosswords - my favorite is Newsday's Saturday Stumper which I consider tougher than the NYT Saturday. But the Super Crossword series relies much too heavily on obscure geography, foreign language and quotations. I expect some of these in every puzzle, but the Super series is riddled with esoterica. I complete about 90% of each puzzle and frankly, don't care to know what I've missed - ie "Afghanistan noble". Themes are not well conceived nor executed and wordplay is lackluster as well. A disappointing series.

Maleska and Samson have gone back to previous collections to find the best puzzles for this super book. Wordplay, puns, anagrams, step-quotes, funny and fanciful theme puzzles are all included, promising new fun for the many fans of the Simon Schuster series.
