Not only are these a nice change from the ubiquitous puzzles that are marketed to casual puzzlers (Sudoku this, Word Search that), the book has exceptional paper stock and an excellent quality to cost ratio. Challenging puzzles, paper easy to write on and erase with no loss of printed ink. The answer section is clearly designated as every page in this section has a grey border. A great book for adventurous puzzlers and casual puzzlers alike.The only concern I have is about the spiral-bound printing. There is a

connector that acts like a standard book spine that basically defeats the premise for the spiral bound printing. It attaches the front and back cover together and prevents the pages from navigating the spirals more than 180 degrees comfortably. You cannot have just one page facing you without difficulty. Masyu was new to me, but is a similar concept - make a continuous line following particular restrictions. Both are logic puzzles. The book starts with easy versions of both puzzles and gets more difficult as it progresses. I am probably half way through both styles. What particularly impressed me about this book is its quality. One of the familiar pleasures of childhood is solving mazes. Now Nikoli presents mazes for grownups mazes without walls! In Slitherlink, the diagrams are open grids, with numbers scattered through them; the solver has to connect the dots in a closed loop, with each number indicating exactly how many lines must surround it. In Masyu, the task is to draw a path through black and white circles, making a right-angle turn at each black circle, and going straight ahead through every white one. Don't let the simple rules fool you--these challenges are guaranteed to keep puzzle fans delightfully distracted for hours on end.
