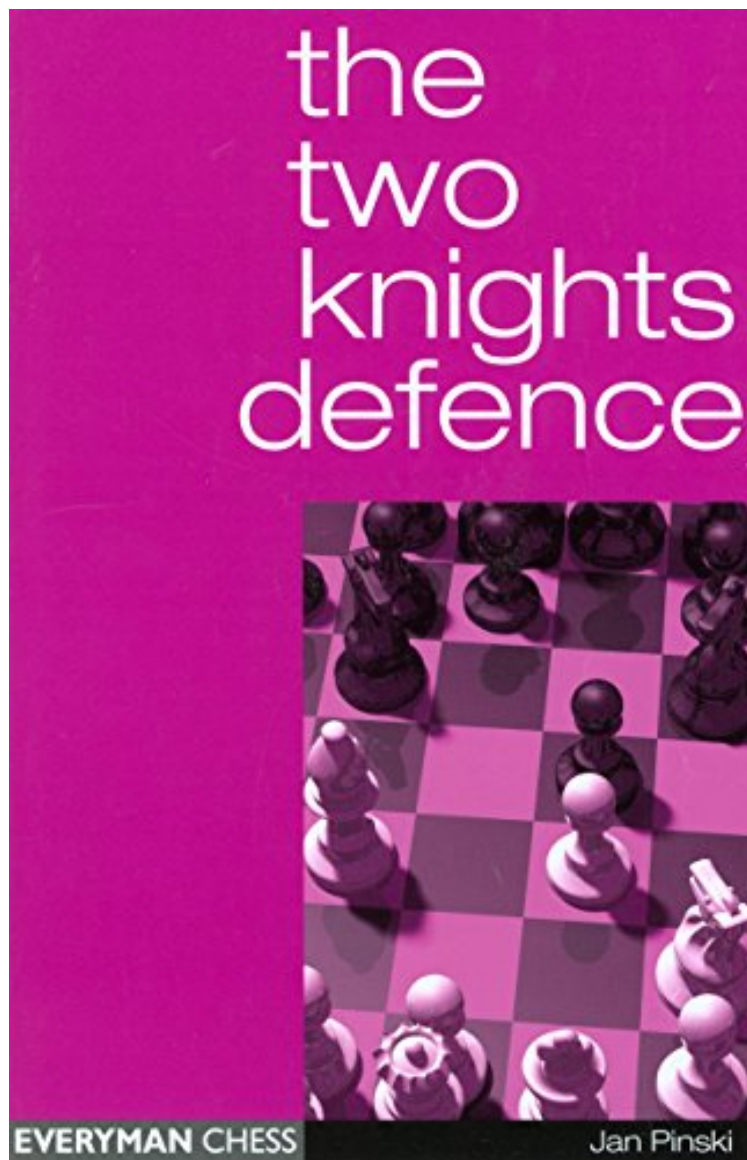

simply says "And white is better" without much insight for the reader about which structural or tactical weaknesses make this to be the case.
