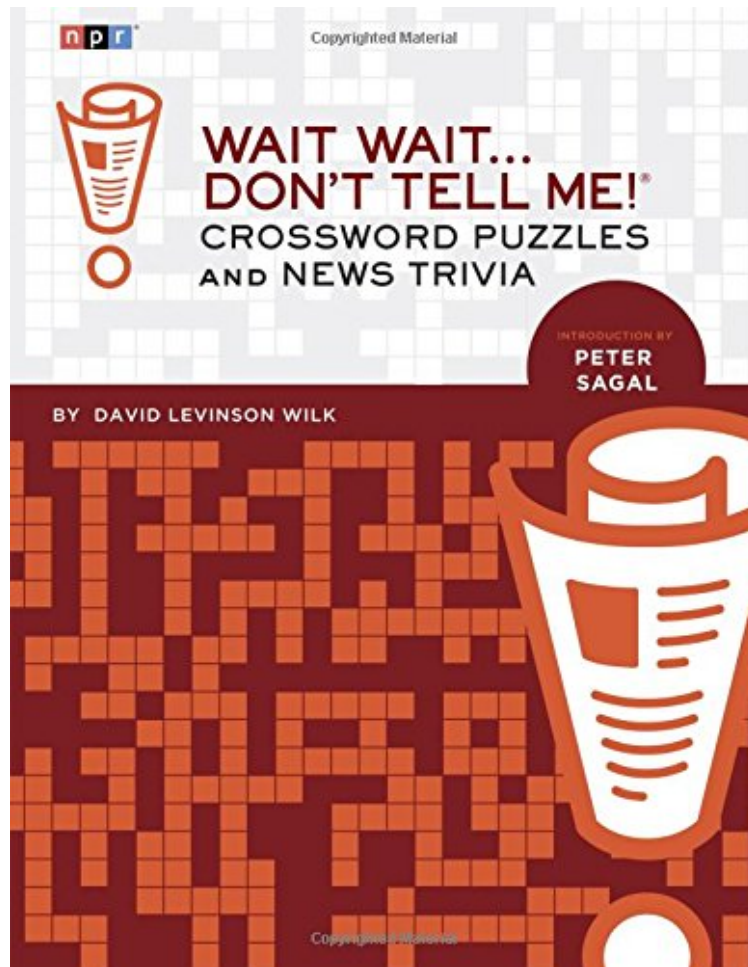

Poor designBy J.I love the radio program, but I wasted \$ on the puzzle book. I've had many crossword puzzle books over the years and find that 3 types work for me: spiral-bound, pages center stapled so the book can be folded back, or put together so that a page can be torn out to work the puzzle. Unfortunately, this book has a flat spine with 4 puzzles printed on one sheet of paper and multiple sheets stacked and folded so that the left side of a sheet makes 2 pages closer to the front, the right-side puzzles end up further back in page-number order. That constriction means a page can't be torn out in a usable way. Also, the flat stiff spine won't allow the book to be folded easily so that pages can be worked one at a time. It is difficult to enjoy working the puzzles if you have to fight the book.

Filled with puzzles and trivia taken directly from NPR's popular news quiz show Wait Wait...Don't Tell Me!, this crossword puzzle book is for every fan who's been itching to put their own trivia powers to the test!
