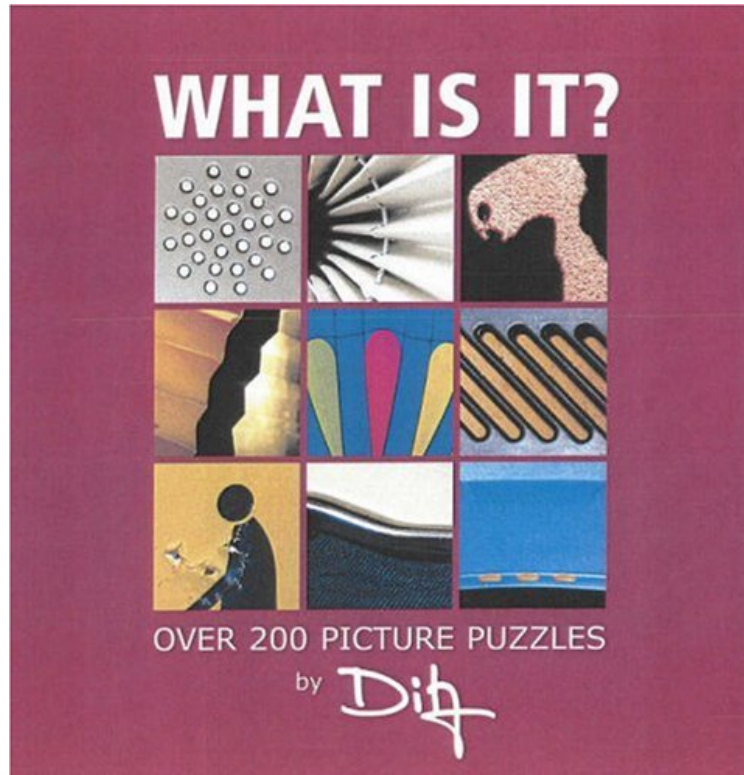

If you think these are easy puzzles,you're in for a surprise.By Jerry GuildIf you've had your fill of Spot-The- Differences Puzzles and want something more challenging,here's the book for you.The book consists of over 200 "What is it? puzzles.If this type of puzzle is new to you ,it is simple to explain.What you are given is a thumbnail sized piece of a larger picture and what you are asked to do is figure out what the whole picture is.Taking it to the extreme ,it would be like trying to find out what a picture is from a piece of a Jigsaw puzzle. A clue as to what you can expect, can be found by looking at an expanded copy of the cover of the book.There are 9 small pictures and you have to figure what each one of them is represented by it.For example ,the picture at the top right is the shadow of pets playing in a sunny room.Like I said,these are tough,if possible at all.In all fairness ,they are not all this elusive;why ,you might even "get' a few.

How's your eye for detail? Well, this clever and quirky puzzler demands concentration and imagination, as the internationally renowned painter and photographer known as Ditz presents more than 200 photographs designed to keep the guesses flying! A small section of each original photograph has been cropped down, creating a completely new image that requires careful consideration to decipher. On the back of each page, the complete, original photograph is revealed, so readers can see if they guessed correctly. Taken in and around the artist's home base of London, as well as other spots throughout Europe and America, the photographs gently remind us to take a new and closer look at everyday objects and celebrate the wonder and beauty that surrounds us.
