The progression of difficulty was done very well. I'm just finishing this book and hoping to find another that I will like as much. After doing the 100 puzzles, I would not buy an easy to hard again because the easy ones would be a waste. Also, I'm not entirely sure how they compare to other books... are the ones at the end of this book the same as a book that says 'challenging' or are they easier? I'm not sure. Either way this was a great starter book for an adult, I definitely recommend.

KenKen can be described simply as sudoku with basic math (addition, subtraction and/or multiplication and division). It's a fun, addictive, clever puzzle that's winning fans the world over.
