I bought this book about 10 years ago to learn a few more new card tricks. Unfortunately I only found about 6 or 7 tricks worth learning. Most of the tricks were either not that good or were not worth learning.The author should learn to explain briefly and to the point. Many of the tricks were explained in 5 or 6 pages which elaborated unnecessary details. The tricks could have easily been explained in 1 or 2 pages each. The author thinks he has to describe every single detail including but not limited to the expression on his face and the size of his fingers. Seriously though, the explanations include unnecessary details and are just way too long. A better title for this book would have been "Read all this and perhaps you'll find a few card tricks worth doing".In conclusion I did find a few nice effects or a different or better approach to doing tricks I already knew. Two better books are "Scarne On Card Tricks" and "Mark Wilson's Complete Course In Magic". Both of these books explain lots of great card magic tricks in

a better and more concise format.
