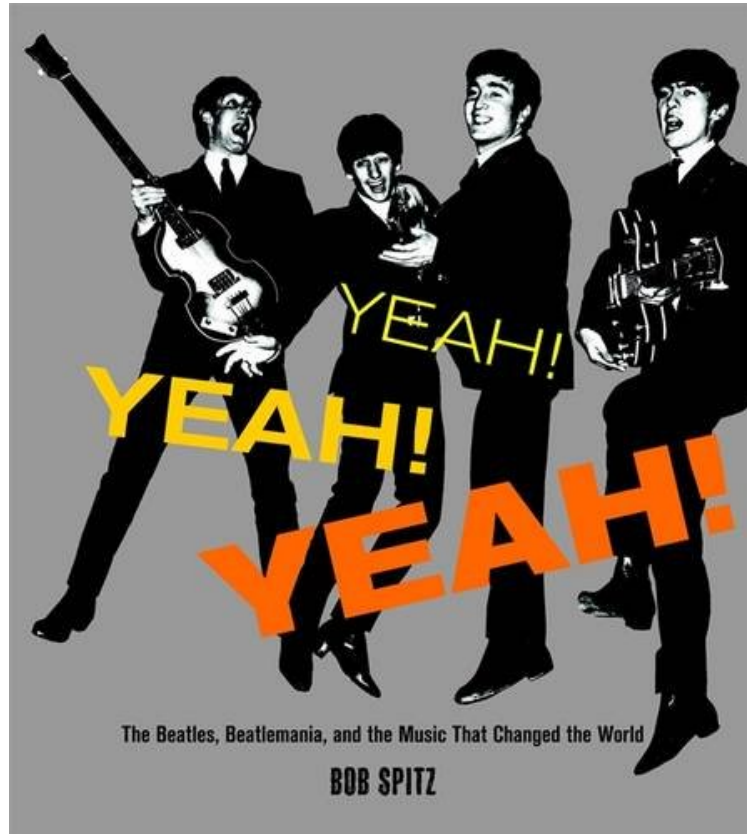

For example, his description of George Harrison is identical to the passage in his other book. I liked that because I felt he was including younger readers into a wider net of Beatle information. Unlike his adult biography which was riddled with errors, this book contained only one error and it was minor. George Harrison's death was given as being on a Tuesday when in fact it was a Thursday. Small thing, yeah, but hyperalert Beatle fans can't help but notice these things. There are some excellent pictures in this book and it is a compliment to young readers' intelligence and a good gift for cultural appreciation/exposure. It starts in the housing projects and school playgrounds of Liverpool, where four boys would discover themselves--and a new form of music called rock 'n roll. It takes us from the famous first meeting between John and Paul, to the clubs of Liverpool and Germany when George and Ringo join the band, down Penny Lane and Strawberry Fields, to America and the height of the Beatles' success--when they were still teenagers. In Yeah! Yeah! Yeah!, Spitz recreates the thrills, tears and magic of his New York Times bestselling adult biography, but in a style and format that's accessible for young readers. This book includes photos, sidebars and graphic elements. It's a book about teens who changed the world.
