What we got was the censored version, which was an obvious assumption, but a guy can dream.Additionally, there is very little in the way of commentary. I would've loved to get insight into how some of the creative processes went when designing the cards from the original story. Generally, art books include such things as short interviews with artists, or perhaps an anecdote or two. This book has none of that.For what it is, though, the book delivers. It's an amalgamation of the cards (real cards, anime exclusive cards are not included) used in the show.
